

Kedron Cheerleading 2018-2019 Registration Information

Welcome

Thank you for your interest in registering your child for the 2018-19 Kedron Cheerleading season. We are a competition cheerleading team that does not have try-outs. Our motto, "EVERYONE CHEERS," is the belief that Kedron Cheerleading was founded upon.

Our Season

The Kedron Cheerleading season is an **8-month commitment**. Our season begins with a one-week mandatory Kedron Camp at the end of August, followed by three practices a week, every Monday or Tuesday night and Saturday (including Christmas break), beginning the first week of September. The competition season begins in January. Our teams compete every Saturday and/or Sunday throughout January, February and March. Additionally, our Pee Wee, Youth, Junior, Senior and Senior Open squads compete in weekend-long Nationals competition in March. During previous seasons, we've traveled to Washington, DC; Orlando, FL; Ocean City, MD; Wildwood, NJ and Virginia Beach, VA.

It's important that all cheerleaders and families recognize the commitment required for competition cheerleading. In addition to attendance at every practice and competition, we ask that families avoid scheduling vacations during the season. This is critical because in order to compete and perform the routines, every cheerleader is needed.

Fees

Kedron Youth Association registration is \$150 per cheerleader.

For cheerleaders who would like to purchase their uniform, the cost is \$175. If you choose to rent your uniform instead of purchase it, the rental fee is \$50. This is due when uniforms are sized.

In addition to these fees, cheerleading has additional costs including: competition fees, uniform fees, gym fees, team tumbling, choreography and camp. Combined, these fees total approximately \$450*. Additionally, cheerleaders on the Pee Wee, Youth, Junior, Senior and Senior Open squads competing at Nationals have a \$115 Nationals competition fee, plus the cost of a hotel. We do our best to fundraise throughout the season to help offset the out-of-pocket costs, and have historically been able to cover all of these National competition fees.

Team Tumbling

We have team tumbling classes at our gym and the fees for these classes are included in your annual fees for the season. Tumbling runs from September to April. These classes are MANDATORY and are considered practices. We may also use these times as an added practice.

Kedron Cheerleading is led by an all-volunteer executive board and coaching staff. Each team is assigned a coach and is supported by head moms (dads) and board members.
